






For the first time in years, the clear and unchallenged hero of the show was not greenery but floral. Whether spring blooms, wildflowers, tropical floral, or playful petals, flowers of all kinds exploded throughout almost every showroom and were typically bursting with color.

There's been a lot of talk about color, but we would be remiss if we didn't quickly mention these warm neutrals that still dominated many of the furniture showrooms. 
SOCIAL MEDIA REPORT HOMDAY 2023



Across all seasons for several years now, we've seen the transitional look be the overwhelmingly dominant trend, and 2023 was no different. As we noted on our Fall 2023 social media report, this theme encompasses everything important happening right now: creamy neutrals, earthy reds, dark woods, touches of history, and a lived-in elegance. Specifically in floral, understated greenery was paired with muted berries, flowers, and citrus, and looks were paired back but sophisticated.


